




TYPICAL FRONT-LOAD DIN MOUNTING METHOD

Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "Dual BT". The Bluetooth passcode "0000". Once pairing is complete, most Bluetooth will connect automatically if the device is in range when the unit is powered-on.
